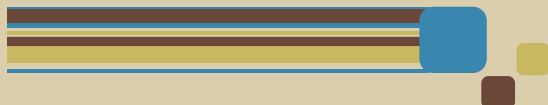
Special thanks to all the parents & volunteers who donated their time & talent to our production.
